Please allow extra time to drive to the Bread of Life Center. It can be tricky to find. Please Google or MapQuest it from your departure location. If you approach from downtown Sacramento, please see the details directly below once you have reached the corner of Del Paso Blvd. and Cantalier Street.

If you approach from downtown Sacramento, at the intersection of the 2000 block of Del Paso Blvd. and the 2400 block of Cantalier Street, you will see “Sammy’s Family Restaurant” and “Swanson and Sons Lock and Safe”. Turn down Cantalier Street. Immediately watch for the black wrought iron fencing on the right and pull into the large parking lot where you will see a white two-story building with two doors, one white and one brown. Please enter the building through the white door on the left and look for Mrs. Stie to check-in and receive instructions.

If you have any trouble locating the building on the day of the event, please call Mrs. Stie’s cell (916 837-7843) and she will direct you to Bread of Life.
